The impact of social violence on female university drop out :

The case of Cadi Ayyad University

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Abstract:

Every year many female students drop out and do not complete their high education. The aim of this project is to show the factors behind this phenomenon. This exclusion can be reflected through many aspects among them the “social violence”. Our research question is at what extend the “social violence” can contribute to female university drop out. In other word, How parental, traditional, social attitudes affect female education at graduate level specially the phenomena of drop out. To do this, we conduct a survey among female students who leave Cadi Ayyad university in Morocco. The findings will guide educational officers currently operating in our country to initiate strategies targeting retention of female students in university.
