## **Title of project: Gender and Political Violence in Moroccan Political Parties**

This research proposal **aims** to analyze the impact of violence on women's political career in political parties, then, we attempt to analyze multiple ways in which acts of violence, strategies of resistance are gendered.

This study is based on three **hypothesizes** that violence pushes women to abandon their political career in parties. In addition, the more gendered violence in political parties increased, the more political representation of women is low. Furthermore, the violence against women in political parties force them to enact their gender submissive roles (i.e. utilizing the support from husbands, brothers...)

In its **methodology**, this research proposal will rely on both quantitative method by administering structures questionnaires, and qualitative one by conducting in depth interviews to approach this phenomenon of violence against women in Moroccan Political Parties.
